- My most amazing recent buy was a set of English Regency hand-blown, panel-cut amethyst drinking glasses. The colour is extraordinary and low-profile crystal looks really chic on a dinner table.
- French designer Jean-Michel Frank was truly original – the work he did in the Thirties has wonderfully clean lines that still seem modern today. There's a pair of Frank's iron and parchment console tables on the site right now that I have my eye on.
- We have a great 20th-century section, showcasing not just furniture and jewellery but interesting modern art too.
- Madrid is a marvellous city for scouring markets – the Mercado de San Miguel is one of the oldest and has been almost reinvented by its recent refurbishment. I also fell in love with Calle Santa Maria in the Old City; there's a great shop there called Tesla.
- Buy things you adore and group similar pieces together. The items that hold the most value are the ones that you love. Never sell them – that's what collecting is all about.
- Deco is popular again, so if you're trying to achieve that look, I'd start by buying something made of wood.
