CTOR couple Michael Shannon and Kate Arrington (above) - and their two adorable kids, Sylvie and Marion — have called Red Hook home for about a decade. Now the loft they rented at 275 Conover St. is on the market for \$6,500 a month. Shannon, Oscar-nominated for his roles in "Revolutionary". Road" and "Nocturnal Animals," has also been in "8 Mile" and "Boardwalk Empire." Meanwhile, Arrington has a number of her own credits, including Broadway roles in "Grace" and "Our Mother's Brief Affair." Their two-bedroom, twobathroom apartment is above a Fairway market in a former warehouse from the 1850s. At 2,000 square feet, it features exposed brick, "Civil War-era" wood beams and arched windows overlooking New York Harbor. High ceilings reach 13 feet in a modern layout with an open kitchen/dining room. Building amenities include a shared roof deck. The listing broker is Carey Larsen, of Citi Habitats.

2nd time around

Michael Bruno (inset), founder of high-end online for art and antiques marketplace 1stdibs, and his partner Alexander Jakowec have listed their massive Southampton spread at 199 Coopers Neck Lane. It's asking \$12.95 million. They bought it for \$15 million in 2015, and were rumored to be contemplating a sale in 2017. Bruno tells The Post the couple is spending more time at their home in Maine. Now officially on the market, the 14,000-square-foot brick home in the Hamptons features 11 bedrooms and sits on 3 acres near the ocean. It

was built in 1910 by lauded architect Grosvenor Atterbury. The listing brokers are Corcoran's Tim and **Thomas Davis.**
